





Fig. a. Music, b. KBCAOS, c. Law, IQAC, d, e. Physics f. Ancient History, g. Statistics h. CBCS



Classrooms are equipped with modern ICT facilities such as projectors, Interactive whiteboards, LAN/WiFi etc. which helps in effective teaching learning. Students use these facilities to hone their communication skills. The outcome of this in the last five years has been complete transformation of students. Many of our students are continuously qualifying national level competitive examination such as NET/JRF/GATE etc. every year. At present, most classrooms have such facilities. These ICT-enabled classrooms have helped students learn more effectively, improve communication, and collaborate with each other. Students and faculty members are advised to use various e-contents available through GoI initiative. Some faculty numbers are taking faculty development programmes offered through NPTEL and ATAL for improving the quality of teaching while the students enrol in several such courses in NPTEL, SWAYAM, COURSERA etc. for additional learning. After these classes, some departments also conduct tests in the form of oral examinations to monitor the progress.

3. Training Programs

A number of training programmes are organised by different departments on various topics with an aim to skill the students, teachers, research scholars with the latest technology, softwares etc. Such as a summer Training Programme on "High Pressure Temperature Research and Analytical Techniques was conducted by NCEMP. DST-SERB sponsored Training Programme on Application of Geospatial Technology in Sustainable Management of Water Resources. SERB DST Sponsored 1- Month Residential Training & Skill Internship Program on High-End State of the art Scientific Equipment's. Special Lecture on Innovative Ideas and Novel Concept for Food Technology Startups. Two days virtual training programme on "Statistical method in food processing". Special Training Program on Animation Technique for Students of M.Voc. Media Studies.

4. Field Studies & Practical Approach

Several courses train the students through field study and practical. BSc Geology and MSc Applied Geology course regularly conduct field excursions to enhance the knowledge and understanding of the subject. MA Anthropology course also conducts similar field trips every year to apply theoretical knowledge in field to understand several complexities. Various other departments also promote field and practical approaches to enhance the knowledge of students. The syllabus of all the course is designed in such a manner where practical, theory, and tutorial classes are displayed.









Online lectures

EFFECTIVE USE OF THE ICT FOR TEACHING, ADMISSIONS, AND E-GOVERNANCE

- University of Allahabad recognized the importance of providing the students with the type of networked computing
 environment they can expect to work. A programme of continual improvement ensures that both hardware and
 software are the latest.
- University of Allahabad has started its transformation towards paperless office under the leadership of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. As a first stage towards paperless office, University of Allahabad started all its internal communications in electronic mode.
- University of Allahabad allows the students and faculty members to access the networked information resources (e-books and journals) anytime and from anywhere.
- University of Allahabad provides secure access, both on and off-campus, to coursework, electronic teaching and learning materials, exam results, and a variety of other information and services, much of which is personalized.
- Wireless network of University of Allahabad is available throughout its academic campus and hostels enabling mobile access to resources from a wide range of personal devices.
- University is continually working and developing innovative ways of using technology to support teaching and learning through virtual learning environment.
- Following ICT facilities are available in University of Allahabad:
 - o 1gbps dedicated internet line
 - o Personal institutional email and personal WiFi facility across different type of devices.
 - Remote access facility to read subscribed books and journals
 - More than 3000 computers and computing devices
 - Availability of high end computing machines for research purpose
 - o Security features are available in University network
- Further, University is planning to enhance its ICT facilities, through incorporation of e-Office and Business Analytics system in University; increasing the bandwidth of internet line from 1 gbps to 10 gbps and placing the recorded lectures of faculty members on web.
- The campus-wide CCTV surveillance system, having pan, tilt, and zoom cameras, with the centralized control room, is being effectively used to cut down the security expenditure on the campus.
- The University is fully utilizing the digital initiative of MHRD, namely the MOOCs platforms like Swayam, NPTEL, ePG Pathshala, Swayamprabha, etc, as well as GIAN scheme to ensure that best and updated lectures are available to the student community.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND STUDENT AMENITIES

- On the occasion of Convocation on 8th Nov 2021, three new buildings including Gargi Mahila Chhatravas, Chandrashekahr Azad International Hostel, and Major Dhyanchand Students Activity Centre were inaugurated by the Ho'ble Union Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, and the Chancellor Shri Ashish Kumar Chouhan.
- Construction of Student's Activity Centre has been completed within the stipulated time and has been named as
 Major Dhyanchand Student Activity Centre. The building will provide facilities for the extracurricular activities of
 the students.
- Construction of Sophisticated Advance Instrumentation Facility and M. N. Saha Centre for Space Studies has been completed. It will provide much needed facilities for the research work.
- Construction of first phase of Girls Hostel and the hostel has been named as Gargi Women's Hostel. In first phase it will provide accommodation for 124 girl students.
- Construction of a new Boys Hostel is completed. It will provide accommodation for 218 Boys students. It has provision for future vertical expansion.
