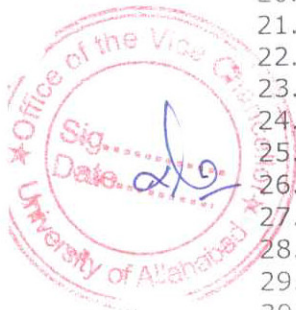

The Chairman welcomed all the members of Academic Council. Thereafter, the agenda item were taken-up.

Agenda No.01/28: To consider the matters relating to admissions for the Academic Session-2017-18 for determination of Seats, Fees and Eligibility conditions etc.

Resolution No.01/28 Resolved that the new fees structure for Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Research has been accepted as under **(Annexure-I)**, for newly admitted students, old students i.e. who have passed B.A. Part-I, M.A. Part-I or admitted in Research will pay the fee that was charged as in earlier years. The cost of admission form in Postgraduate and Professional Courses is also revised as per **(Annexure-II)**.



That in all Undergraduate and Postgraduate examinations there will be cut-off marks in admissions. The cut-off marks will be 30% for General students and 27% for OBC. There will be no cut-off for SC/ST students.

The total numbers of seats in each courses will be demonstrated in Admission Brochure which will include the seats of University and Degree Colleges. The admission in Research (D.Phil.) course will be done through a written test which will be off line and consist of short questions, medium questions and long questions as against MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) in 2017-18.

UGC Regulations 2016 regarding Research were adopted; however, the seat intake for each supervisor for D. Phil course was unanimously modified as follows: Maximum 10 research scholars for Professor, 8 for Associate and 5

for Assistant Professors. The students who were transferred to faculty members from retired faculty members shall be treated as additional (their number shall not be counted in the total number of research scholars under concerned faculty member) and shall be transferred to the new faculty members as and when they are appointed. It was further resolved that in case the number of seats under all faculty member within a department is full, there shall be no vacancy in the concerned department for D.Phil course for the session 2017-18.

This year Academic Council also decided to give preference to fresh candidates in Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Research Courses. Therefore all students who have passed the qualifying exam in the same year in which they appear in the Admission Test will get the benefit and no marks will be deducted from their grand total, but those who appear after the gap of one year 5% marks will be deducted from the grand total similarly two years gap will invite 10% deduction and three years gap will invite 15% deduction. A gap of more than three years will not invite more than 15% deduction.

Resolution No.02/28 It was resolved that a Committee of the following: Prof. A.C. Pandey Chairman, Prof. H.S. Upadhyaya and the Registrar of the University of Allahabad as members, shall workout the modalities after examining the scope of the ordinances/university act for the proposal submitted by Prof. (Dr.) Om Prakash Shukla, Principal, National Defense Academy Khadakwasla, Pune Maharashtra. The committee would examine the issue as per rule and submit the report.

Resolution No. 03/28 It was resolved that Gazette of India No. 278 dated 05-05-2016 regarding (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2016 and Gazette of India No.285 dated 11-07-2016 regarding

(Minimum Qualification for Appointment of Teachers and other academic staff.


- in University and College and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (4th Amendments) Regulations, 2016 time to time be recorded.


The following issues were also discussed under any other matter and were unanimously approved:

- Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was discussed and it was resolved that there should be uniformity across all departments / centres as far as possible. A committee was formed for finalizing the modalities for the same. The Committee shall comprise of the following: Prof. Shanti Sundram (Chairperson) and Prof. Smita Agarwal, Prof. H. S. Upadhyay, Prof. Rishi Kant Pandey, Prof. Bechan Sharma, Prof. M. P. Singh, Prof. Sujata Raghuvansh as members.
- It was unanimously resolved that all degrees of one of our former student, who had indulged in circulating fake email to applicants of Placement Officer just a day before the interview be withdrawn as deterrent. It was also resolved that the exam copies of Mr. Chandan Singh be thoroughly looked into.
- It was unanimously resolved that the candidates having M. Tech degree in Earth System Sciences/Atmospheric and Ocean Sciences/Geophysics/Space Physics from the UGC/AICTE recognized institutions must be exempted from Level 1 and 2 of the CRET in 'Atmospheric and Ocean Science' of the University of Allahabad in accordance with existing provision of the CRET ordinances for other University departments. Also the candidates of the Ministries/Departments of Govt. of India covered under the MoU with the University must be exempted from CRET Level 1 and Level 2 of 'Atmospheric and Ocean Science' of the University of Allahabad.
