Agenda No. 01/35 To consider recommendations of the Selection Committees of the Departments of Chemistry, Zoology and Home Science held under Career Advancement Scheme (CAS).

Resolution No.01/35 As the agenda item was taken up, the matter for opening of envelopes containing recommendations of Selection Committee held in the Department of Commerce & Business Administration earlier in the year 2013 was raised by Prof. Ramendu Roy, Department of Commerce & Business Administration and member of the Executive Council. He was of the view that the envelope(s) of those Selections be also opened in view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court in the matter of Ms./Dr. Shefali Nandan as in that matter a contempt petition is also pending before the Hon'ble High Court. Prof. B.P. Singh, Registrar, University of Allahabad clarified the position of the case and the members of the Executive Council were of the view that the Executive Council shall abide by the directions of the Hon'ble Court in the aforesaid matter whenever it is received by

Agenda No. 02/35

To consider the Rostering and advertisement for vacant teaching posts of the University.

Resolution No.02/35 Resolved that the advertisement for teaching posts be made as per the roster excluding certain posts in the Departments of Botany, Commerce, Defence Studies, Earth & Planetary Science and Environmental Science. The legal opinion be obtained for the pending recommendations of the Selection committees held with reference to previously advertised vacancies of these Departments.

Agenda No. 03/35

To consider reviewing the decentralization of admissions of University Hostels.

Note: The matter related to decentralization of admissions to the University hostels like Sir A.N. Jha Hostel was passed in the Executive Council meeting vide Resolution No. 03/31 dated 01-03-2015.

Resolution No.03/35 Resolved that on account of certain problems reported and for smooth and fair conduct of hostel admissions, the admission in Hostels be done as per the earlier practice of admissions by the Dean Students Welfare through a Centralized system on the basis of merit cum choice for the hostels.

Agenda No. 04/35To re-consider resolution No.11/32 dated 15-06-2015 of Executive Council regarding problems in fixing the remuneration of the retired employees re-engaged in the University

of Allahabad.

Note: The matter related to re-engagement for the retired employees of the University of Allahabad were placed in the Executive Council meeting vide Resolution No. 11/32 dated 15-06-2015 and resolved that on such reemployment the remuneration be fixed at Rs.11,000/- or last pay drawn minus pension, whichever is less.

Resolution No.04/35 Resolved that the matter will be put up in the next meeting of Executive Council with full facts viz. the list of the re-engaged employees and name of the persons who are getting less than Rs.11,000/- as approved by the Executive Council and any other relevant details.

With the permission of the Chair, the Registrar informed that two members of the Committee constituted by the Executive Council for regularization of engages prior to 23.02.1998 namely Prof. A. Satyanarayana (acting as a Vice-Chancellor) and Dr. B.N. Tiwari of Pant Institute joined as Professor at J.N.U. need be replaced to consider the left out cases and that a letter has also been received from the Chairman of the Committee Prof. U.S. Rai for that purpose.

It was resolved that the Committee be re-constituted with Prof. H.K. Dixit, Dean, Science as its Chairman who shall co-opt other members for the Committee.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
