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Agenda III: Revision in Course fee of M.Sc. Food Technology programme.

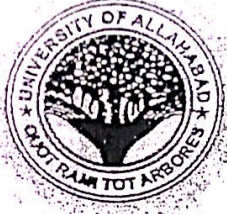

The Resolution II, dated 25.06.2021 of the Programme Committee, Centre of Food Technology (CFT), to introduce 4 year UG and 5 year integrated PG programme from academic session 2021-22 (with multiple exit option as per NEP) in place of M.Sc. Nutritional Sciences programme, was considered.

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The matter was discussed at length and it was resolved that M.Sc. Nutritional Sciences programme be discontinued from the academic session 2021-2022.

The proposal to start a 5 year integrated UG & PG Food Technology programme was accepted in principle and the suggestion of the Programme Committee, CFT, that the resources and infrastructure available for M.Sc. Nutritional Sciences programme be utilized for running the 5 year integrated UG & PG Food Technology programme, was also considered. It was resolved to forward the proposal to the Governing Body of the Institute to consider its administrative and financial viability.

- FFT 700-799 For D.Phil course

The Foundation or General education courses were numbered in 1-10 series (last two digit).

The Core or Skill courses were numbered in 11-50 series (last two digit).

The Elective courses were numbered in 51-79 series (last two digit).

The Seminar and Thesis courses were numbered in 80-99 series (last two digit).

The course structure of B.Voc. & M.Voc in Food Processing and Technology, M.Sc Food Technology, M.Sc Nutritional Sciences, and D.Phil Food Technology/ Nutritional Sciences was discussed and forwarded to Academic Committee for final approval. **(Appendix I and IV)**

 - * The introduction of One year Advanced Diploma in Computer Networking (ADCN) and One year Diploma in Computer Hardware Maintenance.


