

## Information regarding Examinations/Results of the University of Allahabad

### Session 2020-21

The Examinations Committee in its meeting held on 04.5.2021 discussed the issue of examinations and results of different courses for the session 2020-21, in the wake of worsening situation due to COVID-19 pandemic, at length and unanimously resolved the following:


1. The students of UG II, PG and Professional Intermediate Semester courses be promoted to higher classes/semesters, while the students of UG III year be promoted and mark sheets be awarded on the basis of their performance in the previous class. However, the students of UG I and PG/Professional First and Final Semesters will write their examinations in the month of July-August, 2021, as per the decision of the Examinations Committee meeting held on 07.01.2021, depending on the then prevailing COVID-19 pandemic situation.
2. The promotion rules and award of mark sheets for the UG III courses will be as under:
  - i. **For Regular Students:** UG II year marks + 7% increment in each paper separately
  - ii. **For Ex Students:**
    - a. UG II year Marks + 7% increment in each paper separately in the case of B.A. and B.Sc.
    - b. Average marks of UG I and UG II +7% increment in each paper separately in the case of B.Com. and B.Sc. Home Science.
  - iii. If, in any subject, there are two papers in UG II and three papers in UG III, an average of two papers will be awarded in the third paper.
  - iv. If, in any subject, the maximum mark in any paper is say 50 in UG II and 75 in UG III, a simple scaling process will be adopted.
  - v. The highest mark awarded will be the maximum mark -2, and the lowest mark awarded will be the pass mark.
  - vi. Viva-Voce/Practicals/Summer training/dissertation marks will be provided by the concerned Departments/Centres to the CoE office.
3. In the presence of Director Admissions Prof. I. R. Siddiqui, in the examination committee, the issue of DPhil admission roster was also brought up. The committee resolved that for the purpose of the implementation of the reservation policy with respect to CRET 2020 admission in the University, the individual departments of the University are to be treated as separate units as vacancies are to be calculated under faculty members of a particular subject. For the purpose of application of reservation in constituent colleges, the colleges are to be treated as separate units and like University, seats for research admissions

are to be calculated college wise/department wise in order to be in conformity with policy being adopted.

The admissions in the University and constituent colleges shall be finalised through separate meetings of a duly constituted DPC as per regulations. For considering admissions in the constituent colleges, member of the colleges shall be invited to take part in the process in accordance with PhD regulations of University of Allahabad.

4. The results of UG Second examinations (BA, BSc, BCom, BSc Home Sc) will be declared by 30.5.2021.
5. The Second examinations of BCA, MCA and PGDCA will be held in online mode in May 2021 and results will be declared by 30.5.2021
