Internal Examination / Sessional Tests Schedule:

A. AY 2026–27 Onwards

For all UG and PG Programmes (including Professional and Law Programmes) and NEP-based B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Programmes, Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) shall carry approximately 30% weightage of the total marks, with the remaining 70% weightage assigned to the End-Semester Examination. There shall be no CIA/Internal Assessment component in Practical Examinations.

The assessment process shall be planned and completed by the concerned faculty to facilitate submission of consolidated award sheets as per the following schedule:

- **Odd Semester Courses** [I Semester of UG/PG Programmes and III Semester of NEP-based B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Programmes]: on or before **10 December 2026**.
- **Even Semester Courses** [II Semester of UG/PG Programmes and IV Semester of NEP-based B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Programmes]: on or before **30 April 2027**.

B. Existing Batches / Other Semesters:


For students admitted under earlier Academic Regulations, Internal Assessment/Sessional Tests shall be conducted in accordance with the applicable Ordinances, Regulations, Scheme of Examination, and Course Structure of the respective programme.

All Internal Assessments/Sessional Tests, evaluation, and submission of marks shall be completed in time to enable submission of the consolidated award sheets on or before:

- Odd Semester Courses: **25 November 2026**
- Even Semester Courses: **20 April 2027**

NOTES:

1. Departments/Centres/Institutes/Constituent Colleges shall ensure timely completion of all Internal Assessments/ Sessional Tests/CIA, evaluation, moderation (where applicable), preparation of consolidated award sheets, and submission of marks as per the Academic Calendar.
2. Saturdays may be utilized, wherever required, for conducting Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Value Added Courses (VAC), and Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC). To ensure fulfillment of the prescribed teaching hours and effective completion of the curriculum, Saturdays during the Even Semester may also be utilized for conducting classes, Practicals, tutorials, seminars, project work, along with courses under SEC, AEC, VAC, and MDC categories, wherever required. Priority shall be given to completion of the prescribed syllabus of Major/Core courses along with other courses. If the prescribed teaching hours/lectures cannot be completed within the scheduled semester period, the concerned faculty member, in consultation with the Head/Coordinator/Director/Principal of the respective Department/Centre/Institute/Constituent College and the students, may arrange additional classes (offline or online) with proper documentation before the commencement of the End-Semester Examinations.
3. No extra classes shall be conducted on Gazetted Holidays.
4. No class, quiz, presentation, assignment submission, seminar, practical, fieldwork, project evaluation, or any other academic activity shall be scheduled during the notified End-Semester Examination period of the concerned course(s).
5. Saturdays and Sundays may be utilized for the conduct of Internal Assessments/ Sessional Tests/CIA, Practical Examinations, Viva-Voce Examinations, Presentations, and End-Semester Examinations.
6. For Even Semesters, working days are very few, as calculated. Hence, in this period, University will remain open on Saturdays (18th January to 20th April) to cover up the Courses.
7. Each Department/Centre/Institute/Constituent College shall convene its Board of Studies (BoS/ BoBs), wherever applicable, sufficiently in advance. The approved panels of Paper Setters, Examiners, Moderators, and Practical Examiners for End-Semester Examinations shall ordinarily be submitted to the Controller of Examinations by 31 July for Odd Semester Examinations and 31 January for Even Semester Examinations. Moderation of question papers and other examination-related processes shall be completed within the timelines prescribed by the Office of the Controller of Examinations.
8. Delays in the conduct of Internal Assessments/ Sessional Tests/CIA, evaluation, moderation, preparation of award sheets, submission of marks, or submission of approved examination panels may adversely affect examination schedules, result processing, declaration of results, award of grades, and student progression. Responsibility for such delays shall rest with the concerned Department/Centre/Institute/Constituent College.
9. Any modification to the Academic Calendar necessitated by unforeseen circumstances shall be notified separately with the approval of the competent authority.
10. In case of any ambiguity regarding the interpretation or implementation of the Academic Calendar, the decision of the University shall be final and binding.
