International Students must deposit the consolidated fee (including registration fee, university fee and professional fee, as applicable), in favor of the Finance Officer, University of Allahabad. Subsequently, the requisite fee due to the concerned Dean of Faculty/Director of Institute/Head of the Department/Coordinator of Centre will be transferred, accordingly.

The International Students Admission Rules & Procedure -2026 is available on the University website www.allduniv.ac.in for the information of all concerned.

ADMISSION RULES AND PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

(Applicable for International Students taking admission from the year 2026 -27 Academic Session)

1. Introduction

These rules define the procedure for the admission of International Students [Foreign Nationals & NRI category] to various courses/programme of University of Allahabad, Prayagraj, India. *In exercise of power given under the Rule 3 (i) of the University ordinance- XIX, the rules are framed under this category.* These rules are based on General Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Association of Indian Universities and Statutory/Regulatory directives issued from time to time. The candidate who wishes to apply for admission under Foreign Nationals &NRI category is advised to carefully read and follow this “**International Students Admission Rules& Procedure 2026**” which can be seen/downloaded from the University website <http://www.allduniv.ac.in>. It shall be presumed that the candidate applying for admission agrees to abide by the same. The University reserves the right to suitably modify, update or delete any part of these rules and procedure without any prior notice.

2. The Office

The office of International Students Advisor (ISA) and Board shall provide necessary guidance for admission of International Students the various courses/programmes run in the University OF Allahabad (UOA). All correspondence related to international students should be addressed to *the Office of International Students Advisor& Board, 2nd Floor, Prof. Ishwar Topa Academic Complex, Senate House, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj,(U.P.)-211002, India.* The International Students should communicate in the email mentioned below:

All International Students seeking admission to UOA are strongly advised not to use the services of third party/agents/admission service firms. University has not authorized any agency/ individuals/agent to act on its behalf and /or to charge any fee from prospective students. Applicant’s/ inquiries received through middlemen/ third party will not be entertained and will be categorically rejected.

3. Categorization of International Students:

a. Foreign Students:

Foreign Nationals holding passports issued by foreign countries including Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holder who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries are included as foreign students. Provided any subsequent changes in the definition as may be notified by the Government of India shall have the same latest meaning respectively assigned to them. The other expressions not defined herein shall have the meaning as may be assigned in any subsequent notification of the Government of India.

b. Non-resident Indian (NRI) students:

Only those Non-Resident Indian students who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools, colleges, or academic institutions, in foreign countries will be considered as international students. This will include the students studying in schools or colleges situated in foreign countries even if affiliated to the Universities located in India, but will not include students studying in schools or colleges situated in India and affiliated to the Universities or affiliating bodies of foreign countries. Students passing the qualifying examinations from universities located in foreign countries as external students and dependents of NRI studying in India will not merit the status of international students. A person shall be deemed to be NRI (Non-resident Indian) if she/he fulfills the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she, or being dependents of persons so qualified, seek admission in University of Allahabad. The other expressions not defined herein shall have the meaning as may be assigned in any subsequent notification of the Government of India/UGC. **NRI Ward/sponsored category admission:** The candidates seeking admission under this category must have either their parents or sponsor holding NRI status at the time of admission.

Categorization of Admission for International Students: International Students may seek admission to any course offered by the University of Allahabad choosing any of the following modes and order of preference:

a. Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), Government of India Category:

Candidates with nomination/sponsorship by any Foreign State, Embassy or Authority in India/ICCR-Ministry of Govt. of India under the Study in India Programme/Exchange Programme, etc. subject to the condition that the international candidate is eligible to seek admission as per the requirements of the course.

b. Self-Financing International Students:

This provision is available for admission to Under Graduate (UG), Post graduate (PG) courses, Professional courses and Doctoral programme (Ph.D.). Applicants can directly apply to the Office of International Students Advisor (ISA), University of Allahabad within the stipulated time as and when notified by the university. (check <http://www.allduniv.ac.in>)

c. Admission of Foreign students visiting under MOU with International Institutions:

For students from institutions which have signed MOUs with the University of Allahabad, admission will be made under the terms and conditions given in the MOU.

4. General Admission Rule & Procedure:

- a.** Foreign students seeking admission for the 2026-2027 sessions must first register on the Indian Government's STUDY IN INDIA portal (<https://studyinindia.gov.in/admission/login>). A Unique Identification (UID) will be generated on the portal, which will be required during the admission process at the University of Allahabad. Alternatively, they can apply for admission online through the STUDY IN INDIA portal at (<https://studyinindia.gov.in/institute/idashboard?id=2026-27>).
- b.** The International students will be admitted against the 20% supernumerary seats, without disturbing the normal seats of the Under graduate (UG), Post graduate (PG) courses, Professional courses and Doctoral programme (Ph.D.) This will not be applicable to the courses approved by the Bar Council of India and National Council for Teacher Education.
- c.** The above total 20% of the supernumerary seats for international students will not include the international students under exchange programmes or land through Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between institutions or between Government of India and other countries. It is in conformity with the “Guidelines for Admission and Supernumerary seats of International Students in Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes in HEIs in India” issued by the UGC, New Delhi vide D.O. No. 1-1/2022 (CPP-II), dated 30/09/2022.

- d. Out Of the 20% supernumerary seats for International Students, 10% are reserved for Foreign Nationals (FN) in each course/programme of the study in ongoing UG, PG, professional courses and Ph.D. programs, while the other 10% are for Non-Resident Indians (NRI), including the NRI Ward/Sponsored category, in each course/programme of the study in ongoing UG, PG, professional courses except Ph.D. programs. However, for BALLB (Hons.) and LLB courses, only a maximum of two seats in BALLB (Hons.) and four seats in LLB courses, out of the total available normal seats, shall be filled by International Students as per University Rules. Similarly, a maximum of two seats in B.Ed. and two seats in M.Ed. courses shall be filled by international students according to University Rules. Admissions shall be made strictly on the merit of qualifying degree. During admission, preference will be given to foreign national category students over NRI students, and ICCR Category international students will be prioritized over Self-Financed Category international students. *The unfilled seats in the supernumerary category for NRI/NRI Ward/Sponsored category candidates shall not be allocated to anyone other than a Foreign national candidate.*
- e. The International students are exempted from appearing in the Entrance Test for admission in all UG, PG, professional courses, Ph.D. courses/programme subject to fulfilling the eligibility requirement of the course/programme concerned. However, the Ph.D. candidates shall make a presentation of their synopsis before the doctoral programme committee of the respective department in which they are seeking admission. Criteria for selection: In the event that the number of eligible international students seeking admission exceeds the available seats, the selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared according to the prevailing practices of the University. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor is authorized to approve additional seats for foreign nationals.
- f. International students, who wish to enroll under Self-financed category, are required to submit a scanned copy of duly filled application form in prescribed format (Application form is Annexed with this “**International Students Admission Rules & Procedure 2026**”) along with self-signed scanned copies of all the required documents directly to the Office of International Students Advisor (ISA) of the University of Allahabad via email (internationalstudentsoffice@allduniv.ac.in or isa@allduniv.ac.in). Additionally, a hard copy of the same may also be sent via surface mail to the Office of International Students Advisor (ISA), 2nd Floor, Prof. Ishwar Topa Academic Complex, Senate House, University of Allahabad, Prayagraj,(U.P.)-211002, India. If the university adopts the provision of an online application form, international students are required to apply using the same, which will be notified on university website.
- g. The office of ISA, after document verification, eligibility check for the course/programme applied, other related verifications and taking approval from the competent authority, shall communicate the University decision to the respective applicant (and copy to concerned Embassy) for further process. The list of the recommendation for the admission of the international students in each course/programme of study from the office of ISA shall be forwarded to the Director Admission, UOA, who shall ensure the admission and fee deposition as per prevailing procedure/mode of the University for UG/PG/Ph.D. admission. **University of Allahabad does not have at present any provision for scholarships or financial aid for foreign students.**
- h. International Candidates seeking admission under a Cultural Exchange Fellowship programme by the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) category are required to apply through the Indian High Commission/Embassy in their respective countries. Application received in the office of International Students Advisor, University of Allahabad through ICCR will be screened for document verification, eligibility check from respective departments and degree equivalency by AIU (if needed). In case the applicant is found suitable for admission the admission offer letter will be sent to the candidate through ICCR, New Delhi.

5. Eligibility Conditions and documents required:

- a. Minimum eligibility qualifications for international students seeking admission in University of Allahabad in any mode will be the same as for Indian students for each program mentioned in the University admission procedures for various courses/programme. For more details, please visit University website-<http://www.allduniv.ac.in>.
- b. The course/programme on which eligibility is to be relied upon must be from an Institute included in the list of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi- 110002 (<http://www.aiuweb.org>). In case the University/Board is not included in the said list, the candidate has to obtain and submit an Equivalence Certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities.
- c. The following certificates/documents must be submitted along with the prescribed application form:
 - (i) Photocopy of school/Degree certificates, photocopy of marks/Grade statements (In case, if Grade is awarded then the table for conversion of Grades into marks duly authenticated by the concerned Examination Board/University is also to be submitted), Photocopy of Date of Birth certificate, three recommendation letters - at least one recommendation letter should be about academic performance issued by the faculty members of the institute last attended, Photocopy of the syllabi of the last qualifying examination.
 - (ii) Candidate applying under Foreign National category is also required to submit a photocopy of his/her Mark-sheet/ Grade-sheet of Qualifying Examination (both sides) attested either by Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate in his / her country or by the Embassy of his/her country in India at the time of physical reporting.
 - (iii) English translations of all transcripts (wherever necessary), duly attested, are to be submitted. Candidates should get their transcripts attested by the concerned accredited & authorized government agency of their own country and duly certified by the by Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate.
 - (iv) Photocopy of the passport and relevant pages indicating candidate nationality, personal details and others, proof of Nationality duly attested by the Indian High Commission / Embassy / Consulate in Nepal (For Nationals of Nepal only); NRI status certificate as per Annexure A Format [not older than 6 months-if latest NRI certificate of the candidate/dependent is not available at the time of applying, the same may be submitted at the time of admission and such candidates shall submit an undertaking to this effect (Annexure-B)], and relevant pages of the Passport showing Visa and latest exit and entry date. Candidates under the NRI ward/sponsored category must fill out a separate application form and submit additional documents, including the Sponsorship Form (Annexure-C) and a declaration by the candidate's parent or guardian (Annexure-D).
 - (v) Candidate applying under Foreign National category shall also produce documents certifying that he/she is in possession of a valid Student Visa. However, the candidates from the Commonwealth Countries with which the Government of India has treaties shall be exempted from visa restriction. In case of failure to obtain a visa within the stipulated period, the admission shall stand cancelled. A copy of this visa is to be submitted in the Office of the International Students Advisor, University of Allahabad. VISA is not required for NRI students.
 - (vi) Upon arrival in India every foreign student must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer(FRRO).
 - (vii) The candidate has to submit "Anti Ragging Affidavit" from Class 1 Gazetted Officer/Notary and Medical fitness certificate. In case of intervening period/gap is involved, a certificate/affidavit from the Notary Public for the entire intervening period/gap showing candidate's preoccupation after leaving the institution last attended will be required.
 - (viii) *Ineligibility for admission:* During verification of documents or subsequently at any point of time, if the University finds that any certificate/documents or testimonial or information submitted by any candidate is incorrect or false or irrelevant/non-compliant to the requirement, the admission of such candidate shall be cancelled and he shall be permanently disqualified for admission at the University. All the fees paid by such candidates will be forfeited.
 - (ix) Admissions shall be processed on a rolling basis, i.e., in the order of receipt of applications and based on merit, subject to the availability of seats.

- International students from SAARC countries shall be given a special concession of a 50% fee waiver on the registration fee and university fee (excluding the professional fee) for all courses and programs at the UOA.
- International students shall deposit the Consolidated Fee [encompassing registration fee, university fee and professional fee (as applicable)], in favor of the Finance Officer, University of Allahabad. Subsequently the requisite fee due towards the concerned Dean of Faculty/Director of Institute/Head of Department/Coordinator of Centre will be transferred, accordingly.
- International students seeking admission to B.Tech programmes at the University of Allahabad should apply through JoSAA/CSAB/DASA for the respective year
- Other Courses fee and Hostel fee (*International House is available*): It will be communicated along with admission offer letter. No request for any Change of Course/Programme will be entertained after the completion of the admission process.
- The fee refund policy, re-admission policy and any other matter related policies will be the same as that applicable for Indian Nationals. However, the registration fee is non-refundable. Notwithstanding any subsequent revision or modification in the Professional Fee or any other component of the fee structure, the fee as specified in the Admission Offer Letter issued to the candidate at the time of admission shall be treated as final and binding for that candidate for the concerned academic programme.
- The fees are liable to revision from time to time, and students shall be required to pay the revised fees as and when applicable, except where otherwise specified in the Admission Offer Letter.

8. Special Support & Incentives:

The University of Allahabad has adopted the following provisions for the admission of international students, based on the decisions of the Foreign Affairs Committee (meeting held on 18/07/2025), subsequently approved by the Admission Committee (dated 21/07/2025), Academic Council (22/07/2025), and Executive Council (27/07/2025), for implementation from the Academic Year 2025–26 onwards till further review. The review shall be done early.

a. Fee Waiver Provision:

The fee structure for self-finance international students (Foreign Students, Non-Resident Indians (NRIs), and NRI Ward/Sponsored category admissions under the self-finance scheme) shall be waived, similar to the existing provision for SAARC country applicants. This provision shall not apply to ICCR-sponsored students and other government-funded students. It shall also not apply to students admitted in previous academic years who were not granted such concession at the time of admission.

b. PIO-linked Admission Provision:

A child born in a foreign country and holding a foreign passport shall be considered an international student for admission purposes if at least one parent is a Person of Indian Origin (PIO) residing and working in India. Such candidates may be permitted to pay fees applicable to Indian students, subject to due verification and approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

c. Embassy Certification Requirement:

The prescribed format of Embassy Certification shall include a declaration that:
The applicant has no criminal record; and
The applicant is not involved in any serious offence in the country of residence.

9. Hostel Accommodation Facility:

For a safe and comfortable stay, separate fully-furnished International Hostels for Men and Woman, with a combined capacity of 180 residents, are housed within the serene International House Campus.



10. Discipline:

The International Students will abide by all the rules of the University and code of conduct as applicable to Indian students undergoing the same course. Antisocial, anti-national activities, political and religious activities, misconduct, violence and unethical activities involving international students will be dealt with as per extant State and Central laws. The University of Allahabad will not take any responsibility for any criminal or non-criminal offence(s) committed inside or outside the campus by the international students.

11. Examination and award of degree:

The procedure for examination, payment of examination fees, issue of mark list, issue of passing certificates and award of degrees will be same as for the Indian students doing same courses.

12. Transitory Provision:

The “International Students Admission Rules & Procedure, 2026” shall be effective from the date of approval by the competent body and shall not affect actions taken or omitted prior to its implementation. Any matter not expressly provided for in the brochure shall be regulated in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of the University governing international students.

In case of any difference in the interpretation of rules/guidelines or on points not specifically covered, the decision of the Honourable Vice-Chancellor of the University shall be final.

The scanned application form must be sent via email along with the self attested scanned copies of relevant documents/certificates to internationalstudentsoffice@allduniv.ac.in not later than **30th June 2026**.
2. The committee duly constituted by the Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University will meet to finalize the admissions, and successful candidates will be informed via email. Upon receipt of the admission offer letter, the candidates must submit the original documents to the Office of the International Students Advisor and confirm their acceptance by promptly paying the fees as per the prevailing procedures of the University.
3. Application Form should be filled legibly in English by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
4. The applicant should write his/her name, father's name, mother's name as given in the school certificate of Board/University.
5. No column should be left blank in the application form. Incomplete application forms will be summarily rejected.
6. Photocopies of all the required documents/certificates and copies of syllabi as mentioned in the application form should be enclosed. If admitted, the student will be required to produce original certificates/documents at the time of taking admission to the University.
