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INTERVIEW SKILLS (Verbal Communication)

An interview is a formal meeting to ascertain and evaluate the qualifications of a person to fill a particular job situation. It is the only chance for a candidate to present himself/herself to their potential employer. The candidates have limited time to convince and present himself/ herself as the most suitable candidate for the required job. It is a vital step for obtaining a career position and often depends on your skills in marketing your positive potential. Preparation is the main ingredient of the interview. It is important to work on some of the key interview skills to get the desired job. The interview is a mode of interaction which involves both **Verbal** and **Non-verbal communication**. A harmonious blend of both Verbal and Non-verbal communication assures a chance of success in interviews.

The verbal communication refers to the usage of words. Some interview skills related to verbal communication are:

Know your Language: Language proficiency is very necessary in an interview. Do the interview in the language you have command. If your job profile demands any particular language, then prepare and practice that language.

Correct use of grammar: Language must be grammatically error free. Interviewee must work on grammar if he or she finds it a troubling area. Moreover, one should be specific about the sentence construction and the choice of words. Simple sentence formation is relatively helpful and gives fluency.

Avoid jargon and technical vocabulary: To make an impression, the candidates employ heavy and complex words many times. Jargon and complex words impact on the process of communication which might affect the interpersonal understanding of the context.

Usage of appropriate pitch and volume: Speaking tone and volume can help create a positive first impression. Maintain a medium volume, not loud enough to be perceived as irritating or arrogant and not soft enough to be viewed as timid. A pleasantly pitched voice of medium volume can show etiquette.

Be clear and concise: Give answers to the point. Be clear and concise with the answers. Try to express the knowledge with the fewest words.

Active listening skills: For proper answering, firstly it is important to listen well. Pay attention to the words of the interviewer and stay focused. Selective listening or listening out of context may distort the entire communication. Listening does not mean to jump over the answer immediately after the interviewer half finishes his or her question.


Effective use of presentation/visual aids: These days interview processes are highly professional and technical. In addition to the common practice of discussion and subject interaction, the candidates are mandatorily asked to make formal presentation using latest or existing technology. Skilled communication is also fundamental for proficient presentations.


Do not argue: Never try to mislead the interviewers, if you don't know the answer; apologize for that and move forward. One should avoid displaying any form of anger or discontentment for not knowing the answer or any concept.
